

WAMICON 2009 POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Poster presentations will be held during the reception on Monday, April 20. Among the posters will be those associated with papers that were submitted through the regular, peer-reviewed process – final papers from these authors must be uploaded to the EDAS web-site. As with papers that are presented during the oral session, poster presentation papers are not considered complete if the author does not register for the conference and participate in the poster session. Incomplete papers will not be registered with IEEE Xplore.

In addition to the regular poster session papers, other student attendees are invited to present posters during the poster session (a.k.a. non-reviewed student posters).

Attendee Category:

1. Reviewed poster: follow this guideline.
2. Non-reviewed student poster: submit poster title, abstract, author name/affiliation to Simon Wood (Simon_Wood@cree.com); follow this guideline.

Time and Location

The poster session will be held between 6:00PM and 7:00PM on April 20, 2009 at the Sand Key Marriott.

Display boards

The display foam boards are 30" x 40". One board will be available for each poster.

Student Poster Competition

Student posters are eligible for the student poster competition. A panel of judges will evaluate student posters during the poster session and nominate the best student poster. The score of student posters will be determined by the following criteria:

- a. Quality of presentation (e.g., clarity, organization, style, etc.)
- b. Sufficient depth and breadth of research
- c. Innovation and impact of research
- d. Verification and/or validation of results
